The Road Ahead



- Info and anti-stigma campaign – state employees
- Standards to document and measure consumer involvement
- Contract and reimbursement structures to improve tribal and state government relationships.
- Population based (vs. organization based) screening instruments– to support early identification and referral to services.
- Science to Service projects to support Oklahoma-based academic research focused on direct service improvements
- Statewide rural-based telemed work
